The Linacre Wall 500 years of medicine, 1518–2018

In 2018, the RCP celebrated 500 years of medicine. The Direct Debit guarantee

The guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits*.

If you request the organisation to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request. If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when the organisation asks you to. You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society.
